**NOTICE OF APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY  
FOR  
JOURNEYMEN ELECTRICAL WIREMEN**

The Motion Picture Industry Joint Electrician Apprenticeship Committee (JAC) will be accepting applications for apprenticeships from **Monday May 17, 2010** through **Friday May 21, 2010**. Applications can be picked up and turned in at the offices of **Contract Services Administration Training Trust Fund at 2800 Winona Avenue, Burbank, California 91504** from **8:00 a.m. until 4:30p.m. ONLY during the dates indicated.**

**You must apply in person in order to be considered.**

**Applicants must meet the following minimum qualifications in order to be considered for this apprenticeship program:**

1. Must be a minimum of 17 years of age in order to apply. However, applicants selected from the pool of those interviewed must be at least 18 years of age before being indentured.
2. Must be at least a high school graduate, have a GED, **or** have a two-year Associates Degree or higher. Must submit a DD-214 to verify military training and/or experience if applicant is a veteran and wishes to receive consideration for such training/experience.
3. In order to qualify for an interview, applicants must pass the electrical trade's aptitude test developed and validated by the American Institute for Research.
4. Before being indentured, applicants selected from the pool of those interviewed may be required to provide results of a physical examination and drug test.
5. Individuals who can verify, by providing the proper documentation, that they worked a minimum of eight thousand (8,000) hours specifically in the electrical construction trade do not need to meet requirements 2 above and a) below.
6. Individuals who have worked a minimum of forty-five hundred (4,500) hours as a Residential Wireman under a IBEW/NECA local collectively bargaining agreement do not need to meet requirements 2 above and a) below. In addition, you must provide the proper documentation in order to verify work as a Residential Wireman.
7. Individuals who have completed at least three years of related instruction and forty-five hundred (4,500) hours of "on-the-job-training" as indentured in a properly registered electrical construction apprenticeship program not sponsored by the IBEW/NECA do not need to meet requirements 2 above and a) below. In addition, you must provide proper documentation in order to verify work in such an apprenticeship program.

**In order to be considered for this apprenticeship program, applicants must provide the following at the time of submitting an application:**

1. Documentation to show evidence of the successful completion of either one full year of high school algebra with a passing grade; **or** one post high school algebra course with a passing grade; **or** successful completion of online course at the National Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee (NJATC) website at [www.njatc.utk.edu](http://www.njatc.utk.edu).
2. An official transcript for high school and post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
3. A valid driver license **or** a State, or Federally issued identification card.
